- Always show respect to everyone involved.
- Stick to the rules and celebrate the spirit of Martial Arts.
- Encourage fair play and high standards of behaviour.
- **Always** respect the **Officials** and other teams and encourage my students to do the same.
- Never engage in, or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive behaviour.
- Be aware of the potential impact of bad language and behaviour on others.
- Be gracious in victory or defeat.
- Respect the training facilities and those at competitions.

When working with students, I will:

- Place the well-being, safety and enjoyment of each student above everything.
- Never tolerate any form of bullying.
- Ensure all activities are suited for the student's ability and age.
- Work with others (eg Officials, other coaches, Welfare Officer) for each student's best interests.

I understand that if I do not follow the Code of Conduct, i may be:

- Required to meet with the club Welfare Officer – Gary Locke.
- Suspended by the club.
- Required to leave, lose my position within the club.
